Kindergarten	Focuses on Jewish holidays, Jewish home and family life, aleph-bet letter recognition, mitzvot and Torah. Grade Three	Students will learn to read and write Hebrew in preparation for their Siyyum Ha Sefer service. Grade Four	Students expand Hebrew reading and writing skills, and study holidays, music, ethics, midrash, and current events. Grade Five	Focus is on Torah and will include three study sessions with parents. Other topics are current events, menschlekeit, music and Israel. Grade Six	Students will explore the B'nai TELEM curriculum and participate in six Tikkun Olam projects.
