

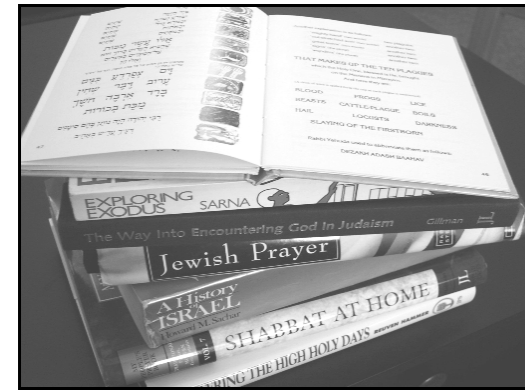

What happens when we die? Judaism has struggled with this question through the centuries. During the Biblical period, Judaism had very little to say about an afterlife. However, a rich tradition of thought and a variety of beliefs on the subject grew during the rabbinic period, in parallel to Christianity's development. Views continue to evolve through the centuries. Our study of Jewish teachings on the meaning of death will help us think about the meaning of life, as well.
